The following works will take place between Monday 30 August and Sunday 12 September 2010 (weather permitting).

TRAFFIC AND COMMUNITY IMPACTS

- Due to wet weather delays, work on the Bicentennial Bikeway is not expected to be completed until mid-September 2010.
- Where possible construction work will be undertaken seven days a week, between 7am and 5pm, with some night works, as required.
- Between 9am to 3:30pm there may be short delays of up to two minutes managed by stop/go traffic control so that finishing works including landscaping can be completed.
- Bikeway users have been switched onto the new pathway.
- Temporary closure of the car park on the riverside of Coronation Drive in the vicinity of Land Street. Car park will remain closed until around mid-September 2010.
- Access along the bikeway between Lang Parade and Land Street will be managed by traffic controllers from 5am to 7pm daily.
- Access along the bikeway between Lang Parade and Land Street will change for the duration of construction. A temporary side track along the bikeway has been installed for cyclists.
- Cyclists are to follow the direction of traffic controllers at all times and are asked to proceed with caution through the construction zone.
- During construction hours pedestrians are to use the footpath along the land (Milton) side of Coronation Drive in the vicinity of the construction zone. This detour is clearly signed.
- Traffic may be stopped for short intervals to allow construction machinery to enter and exit work sites.
- **Cycle traffic speed through the construction zone is reduced to 10km/h for the duration of the work. Safety is our number one priority. Please travel carefully.**
