## O'Keefe and Fern Streets

### Temporary cycleway and pedestrian diversion

From Tuesday 16 March 2010, there will be a change to the temporary shared cycle / pedestrian path, alongside the South East Freeway between Oxford and O'Keefe Streets.

The map on the right indicates the new temporary path which runs along the edge of the work site, across the existing busway ramps and then joins the existing path at O'Keefe Street.

This temporary diversion will allow construction to continue for the new busway ramp connecting the Eastern Busway to the existing South East Busway. This work will also include construction of a new section of shared cycle and pedestrian way as part of the busway project.

**This stage of the diversion will be in place from Tuesday 16 March 2010, for approximately six months.** Cyclists and pedestrians will be diverted via a 3 metre-wide asphalt path.

Traffic control officers will ensure the safe passage of cyclists and pedestrians past the site entrance gate during construction working hours. Short delays may be expected.

Directional signage and night lighting will be installed to guide users through the diversion.

**Cyclists are encouraged to please travel with caution and obey signage and traffic officers.**

Once completed, this 1.05km section of the Eastern Busway will allow commuters to bypass four sets of traffic lights and the heavily congested Logan Road/O'Keefe Street roundabout at Buranda saving commuters nearly 1.5 hours in travel time per week.
