

Cycle Queensland – 9 day cycling paradise

As a volunteer it is your aim to be helpful and friendly to the riders and other volunteers and to work efficiently with your team to contribute to the success of the ride. BQ will work with you to ensure your own goals are fulfilled and that your volunteering is rewarding.

Clean-Up Team - Job Description

Team Role:

- To keep the camp-site clean & tidy during occupation by Cycle Queensland
- To remove rubbish from Catering and Café as it is produced.
- To ensure the campsite is left free of rubbish after the camp has broken.

Areas of operation:

Campsite

Sun exposure: Medium to High

General hours of operation:

From: 6am *To:* 9am plus some delay for last person to leave

From: 11am to 11.30am and *From* 2pm to 2.30pm bin distribution around site

From: 4pm *To:* 9pm

Busiest time: Before and during meal serving times (6 to 7.30am and 4 to 7pm) the caterers and the Café produce a large volume of waste that needs to be quickly removed.

Rest day: Meal times are the same although less rubbish the night before the rest day. General monitoring of bins and campsite rubbish.

Note: you will not need to work all of these hours. Your team leader will schedule as needed. All crew not required at all times but all crew required during busiest times.

Part time volunteers: Help during the peak evening period from 5pm to 8pm.

Equipment supplied to you (must be returned at end of ride):

Gloves (throw away when need to be replaced or when finished)

Cutting knife

Key things to note:

- Your own safety and hygiene are important – wear the gloves provided, use handling equipment provided, seek assistance if unsure and wash your hands well.
- Be smart and the job is easier eg. emptying a half full bin twice rather than a full bin once.
- Each day some of the team remain at the campsite to ensure it is left in good condition and that all rubbish is cleared. Cycle Queensland prides itself in leaving all sites clean and in good order.

Transport between towns:

Generally in the bus, with other Support Crew, except for the campsite close person and assistant who will be allocated an official vehicle.

Meals:

Breakfast (served 6 to 7.30am): Please eat early so you can be ready to help clean up.

Lunch: when suits you.

Dinner (served 6 to 7pm): When you can in coordination with your Team Leader so that Catering and Cafe rubbish is adequately dealt with.

A reminder that the event is a dynamic environment. Not all tasks and issues can be foreseen. If the situation requires, you and your team may be required to perform extra tasks, possibly at different times to your normal hours. You may also be relocated to another team.
