

Cycle Queensland – 9 day cycling paradise

As a volunteer it is your aim to be helpful and friendly to the riders and other volunteers and to work efficiently with your team to contribute to the success of the ride. BQ will work with you to ensure your own goals are fulfilled and that your volunteering is rewarding.

Campsite Logistics Team - Job Description

Team Role:

- To take down and setup marquees for Ride Reception, Medical, Massage, Café (x4) and erect fencing around Café, Catering and other areas as the site may require.
- To take down and setup the entry portal on the campsite each day.
- To assist other teams, and generally around the campsite, with equipment and transport.

Areas of operation:

Campsite

Sun exposure: High

General hours of operation:

From: 7am *To:* 4pm including transport to next site

Busiest time: Early morning pack up before leaving for the next site and then immediately on arrival at the next site since other teams are waiting for their marquees.

Rest day: No scheduled tasks.

Note: efficient and smart work methods will mean an earlier knock off time.

Equipment supplied to you (must be returned at end of ride):

Gloves (throw away when finished)

Key things to note:

- You will be lifting heavy loads and swinging sledge hammers – **safety first!**
- You will also be involved in setting up the start site and the finish site.

Transport between towns:

Generally in vehicles controlled by the team although some will travel by bus.

Meals:

Breakfast (served 6 to 7.30am): you can eat during normal time

Lunch: a short break only, generally at a time after the key marquees are erected

Dinner (served 6 to 7pm): you can eat during normal time

A reminder that the event is a dynamic environment. Not all tasks and issues can be foreseen. If the situation requires, you and your team may be required to perform extra tasks, possibly at different times to your normal hours. You may also be relocated to another team.
